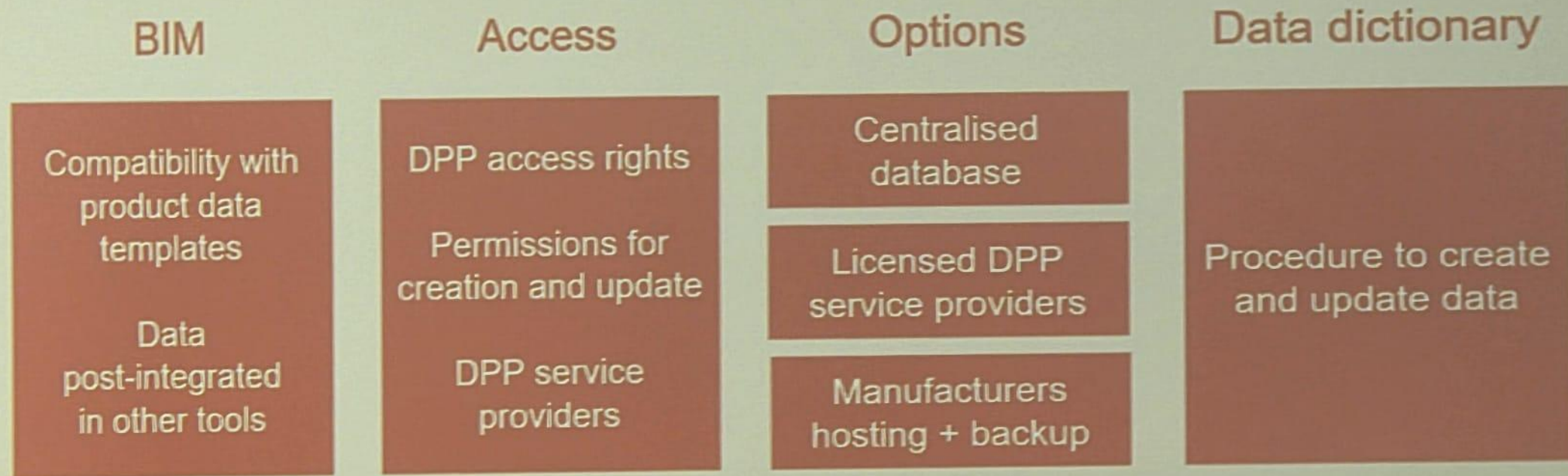
CPR Delegated Act Article 75

Harmonised technical specifications and European assessment documents

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Harmonised technical specifications and European assessment documents

Human and machine-readable format

Standards and EAD provide guidelines to ensure interoperability

Information provided in a structured way in tables in a section of the harmonised standards or EAD

Technical content developed by technical experts without the need for IT training

Structured data to be digitalised using IT tools or as part of the DPP service provider contract

Citation of harmonised standards and EAD trigger the implementation/update of the data dictionary

Digitalisation

Timeline:

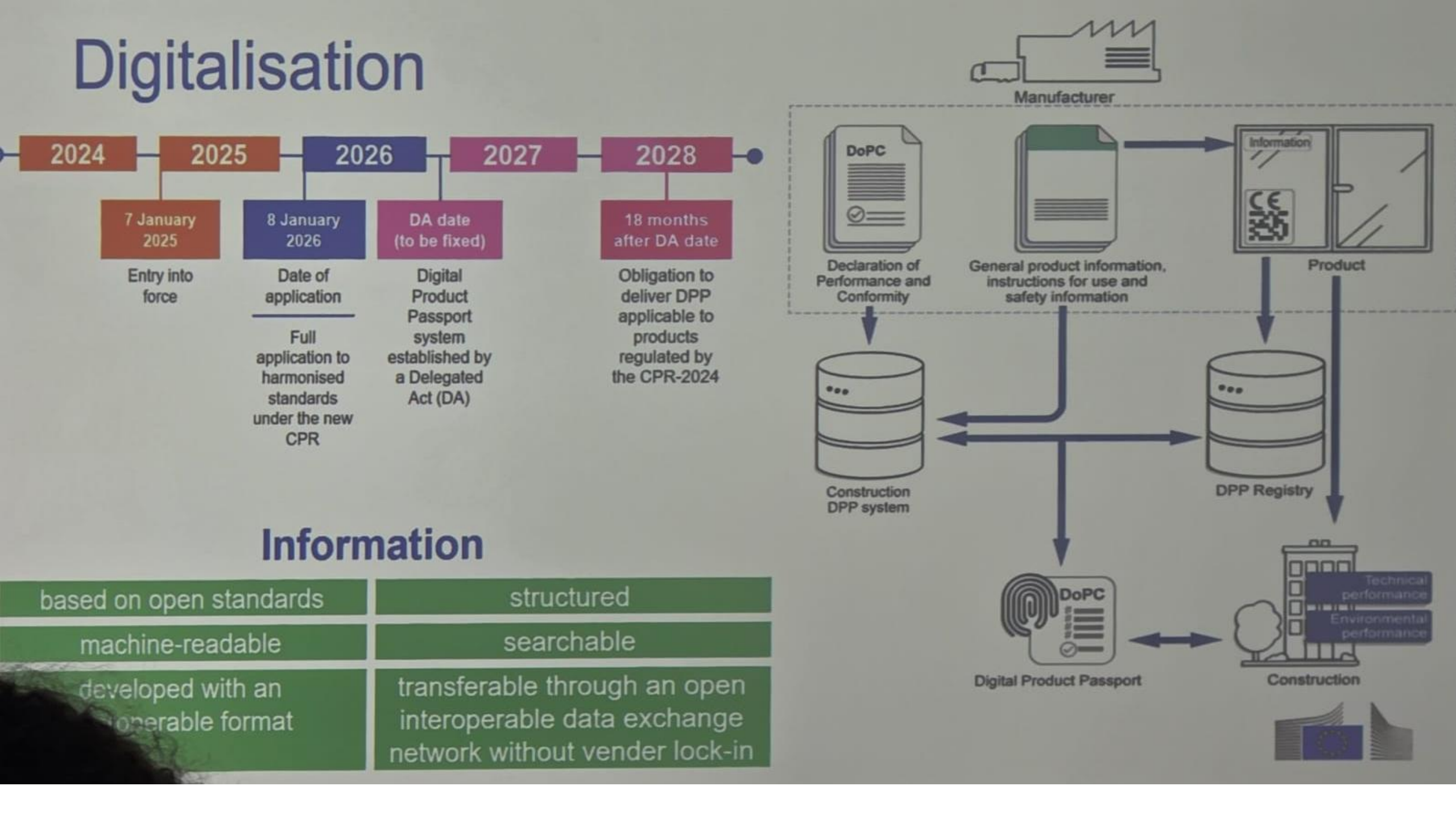
- 2024:** Entry into force
- 2025:** 7 January 2025
- 2026:** 8 January 2026 (Date of application)
- 2027:** DA date (to be fixed) (Digital Product Passport system established by a Delegated Act (DA))
- 2028:** 18 months after DA date (Obligation to deliver DPP applicable to products regulated by the CPR-2024)

Information

based on open standards	structured

Architecture:

- Manufacturer:** Provides Declaration of Performance and Conformity (DoPC) and General product information, instructions for use and safety information.
- Construction:** Provides Technical performance and Environmental performance data.
- Digital Product Passport (DPP):** Central hub receiving data from both Manufacturer and Construction.
- Construction DPP system:** Receives data from the DPP.
- DPP Registry:** Receives data from the DPP and provides information to the Product.
